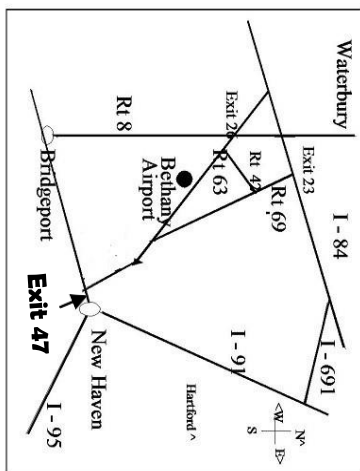

RULES & REGULATIONS

Every class offered is conducted and judged in accordance with the rules and specifications of the current CHSA, and NEHC rule books. In order to compete for annual awards in these organizations membership is required. Membership is required to enter CHJA and NEHC Medal classes. Membership forms, rule books and class specs are available at Secretary's Stand and at chsaonline.com, chja.net and nehc.net.

1. Please Pre-Enter: All entries received by mail or fax prior to 6:00 PM, the Friday, before the show will cost as listed. Payment not due until day of the show. After 6:00 pm. Friday a \$20 post entry fee will be charged for the day.
2. Open to all riders. It is not necessary to be a CHSA or NEHC member, but to compete for those Annual Horse Awards, the horse or pony must be registered by a member of the respective Association. Ages as of 12/1/16. Juniors under 18.
3. Management may cancel/combine/add/divide classes or alter the schedule, or not delay classes due to conflicts with exhibitors or trainers. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to notify management of conflicts in advance to institute reasonable holds. No refunds.
4. Decision of Judges is final. No one may approach a Judge regarding a decision or check a Judge's Card unless s/he first obtains permission from the Steward
5. Proper attire required. In hunters, hunt equitation and jumpers hard hats with full harness required for all jumping, in competition or in schooling. No martingales or tie-downs in any flat classes.
6. Entry Fees must be paid or an open check left before numbers are issued.
7. Judges or Show Committee may excuse any horse, rider or spectator considered unsound, unmanageable or discourteous. Entry fees will be forfeited.
8. Dogs must be leashed for safety. A \$25 fee will be charged for loose dogs.
9. To be eligible for Championship and/or Stake classes, the exhibitor or horse must have shown in at least one qualifying class in that division.
10. Class fees: \$25; Stake classes \$30. Medals \$30.00.
11. Only officials in ring unless at request of the Judge.
12. No alcohol permitted on the grounds.

EQUITATION DIVISIONS

LEAD REIN - CHSA -

Children under 7 (Hunt Seat) or under 8 (Stock and Saddle Seat) as of 12/1/016 who have not competed in other than lead rein classes. To be led by an adult.

WALK, TROT / JOG - CHSA- NEHC 'B' -

Open to riders 10 and under as of 12/1/16, who have not shown in classes requiring them to canter or jump. May not enter into any other classes. Will be divided if entries warrant. Hunt Seat, Saddle and Western Seat

SHORT STIRRUP EQUITATION - CHSA - NEHC 'B'

Riders 12 and under as of 12/1/16 who have never competed over fences exceeding 18" in a recognized show. 18" X rails. Riders may not enter into any other classes except Short Stirrup Hunter and Pleasure. Classes.

BEGINNER RIDERS 11 AND OVER (as of 12/1/16) - CHSA

Juniors and Amateurs in their first years of showing and who have not cantered or jumped at any recognized show. Riders are not eligible for any other divisions. To be shown at a Walk, Trot or Jog only. Will divide English & Western/ Adults and Juniors if entries warrant.

MAIDEN HUNT SEAT - No Points - Open to all ages 2'3"

Riders who have not won a blue ribbon in Hunt Seat Equit. at a recognized show.

WALK, TROT, CANTER OPEN HUNT SEAT EQUITATION -CHSA

Open to junior and adult amateur riders who have never competed over fences in a recognized show. Walk, trot, canter. May not go in classes over fences.

PRE-CHILDREN'S HUNT SEAT EQUITATION – CHSA - CHJA

Junior riders eligible for Limit Equitation and who have never shown over fences over 2'6" at a recognized horse show. At the same show riders may not cross-enter into Children's Equitation, Children's Hunter Pony, Pony Hunter, any medal class over 2' 3" or any classes where fences exceed 2'6". Horses or ponies - fences 2'0"

CHILDREN'S HUNT SEAT EQUITATION - CHSA - NEHC 'B'

Exhibitors not to have shown over 3'. Fences 2' for small and medium ponies. Large ponies and horses to jump 2' 6" No combinations. Riders may not cross enter into Junior Equitation or any classes with fences over 3'.

JUNIOR EQUITATION - CHSA - 3'

Riders under 18. May not crossenter into Children's Equitation at same show.

MODIFIED ADULT AMATEUR HUNT SEAT EQUITATION - CHSA - NEHC 'B'

For those who have not won 6 blue ribbons in any recognized adult equitation class excluding Modified Equitation. For those who have won 6 blue ribbons they are still eligible for Modified if as of 12/1 of the current show year they have not shown in classes with fences 3' or higher at more than 3 recognized shows within the past two years. Fences 2'6".

ADULT AMATEUR HUNT SEAT EQUITATION - CHSA - NEHC 'B'

Open to amateur adults 18 years of age and over as of 12/1/16.

JUNIOR SADDLE SEAT EQUITATION - CHSA - NEHC 'B'

Open to Juniors 17 and under as of 12/1/16

WESTERN SEAT EQUITATION - CHSA - NEHC 'B'

Junior Western /Reining Seat juniors 17 and under as of 12/1/16 Adult Western/Reining Seat Amateur Adults 18 and over as of 12/1/16

MEDAL CLASSES

Riders must be NEHC members – may join at the show

Members and non-members, but only CHSA members will accrue points. At least 3 riders must complete the class. Two tests included in class. One CHSA medal class per show.

HUNTER DIVISIONS

Regular classes \$25; Stake = \$30 Stake Distribution \$30, \$20, \$10, \$5

SHORT STIRRUP HUNTER CHSA - NEHC 'C'

Riders 12 and under as of 12/1/16. Must be eligible for Short Stirrup equitation. Fences not to exceed 18", cross rails or verticals.

CT TRAINING HUNTER LEVEL A - 18"; B – 2'; C – 2'3"; D - 2'6" CHSA

Open to all riders and horses or ponies, no restrictions of horse/pony/rider into other divisions if other-wise eligible. Simple lead changes or trotting in corners permitted. Classes may be combined if entries warrant. **Hunter type courses.**

PRE-CHILDREN'S HUNTER CHSA - CHJA - NEHC 'C'

Junior riders, horses or ponies. Fences 2'0." Must be eligible for Pre-Children's Equitation. At same show horse/pony and rider combination may not cross enter into Children's Equitation, Children's Hunter Horse/Pony, Modified Children's Hunter or classes where fences exceed 2'6".

MODIFIED CHILDREN'S HUNTER - CHSA

Junior exhibitors eligible for Children's Equitation. Horses or ponies – fences 2'6". Same horse/pony/rider combination may not enter other classes exceeding 2'6"

LOW HUNTERS – Unrated

Open to all. Fences about 2'6"

CHILDREN'S HUNTER - CHSA - NEHC 'B'

Open to horses and ponies ridden by a Junior eligible for intermediate equitation over fences as of 12/1/16. Same combination rider and mount are not eligible for any other recognized division except equitation and pleasure. Will be divided horses and ponies if entries warrant. Small & medium ponies 2', large ponies 2'6", horses 3'

MODIFIED ADULT AMATEUR HUNTER - CHSA - NEHC 'C'

Adult amateur riders who are eligible for Modified Equitation. Fences about 2'6".

ADULT AMATEUR HUNTER- CHSA - NEHC 'C'

Open to amateurs 18 and older. Fences about 2'9".

NON-JUMPING HUNTER - CHSA - NEHC 'C'

Open Hunter Pleasure: Open to all horses of a hunter type ordinarily used for pleasure purposes with no limitations as to the status of the rider.

Quarter Horse Hunter Under Saddle: Open to Junior and adult riders. All horses must be registered with the AQHA, papers to be presented if requested.

JUMPER DIVISIONS

Regular classes \$25; Stake = \$30 Stake Distribution \$30, \$20, \$10, \$5

LOW TRAINING JUMPER - CHSA

Open to horses/ponies; riders any age. Fences 2'6".-2'9"

LOW AMATEUR ADULT/CHILDREN' JUMPER - CHSA - NEHC 'C'

Open to juniors and adult amateurs. Fences - 3' - 3'3".

PLEASURE DIVISIONS

Championships & Reserves awarded on Points Accumulated

PLEASURE CLASSICS (Must have 4 to run)

\$100 English Pleasure Classic: Open to all who have shown in at least one English pleasure class division at this show. \$50, \$25, \$15, \$10. Entry fee \$30.

\$100 Western Pleasure Classic: Open to all who have shown in at least one Western pleasure class division (including breeds) at this show. \$50, \$25, \$15, \$10. Entry Fee \$30.00.

ENGLISH PLEASURE - CHSA

Adult English Pleasure: English tack and attire Junior
English Pleasure: Under 18 as of 12/1/16

WESTERN PLEASURE - CHSA

Open Western Pleasure: Will be divided Adult and Junior if entries warrant.

GREEN HORSE OR PONY (unrated)

Open to horses and ponies in their first years of showing. English or Western Walk, trot/jog, canter/lope.

CHILDREN'S PLEASURE PONY - CHSA - NEHC 'C'

English or Western. Must be ridden by Juniors. Walk, trot/jog, canter/lope.

ACADEMY CLASSES

Riders: Never to have shown at a canter. Ineligible for any other classes. Attire: Helmets mandatory. May have jods, shirt, tie, vest, gloves and boots. No jackets or full riding suits. Horses: open to lesson horses only. Snaffles, or full bridles. Martingales optional.

AFFILIATION PLEASURE CLASSES

Open to all, horses and ponies. Not necessary to be a member CHSA
English Pleasure . NEHC Open Pleasure

DRIVING DIVISIONS - CHSA -

NEHC 'C' (Carriage Driving only)

Open Carriage Pleasure Driving: Open to all horses/ponies of any breed,color or size. Shown at Walk, Slow trot, Working trot, Strong trot. Should halt and rein back

Open Pleasure Driving: Open to both horses and ponies. Manners paramount. May be shown to any two to four wheeled vehicle , type of harness optional.

All entered for competition shall be under the control of the Committee and subject to the constitution and rules of the Associations and the local rules of the competition. Should any dispute or question arise, it shall be referred to the Show Committee, whose decision shall be final. I, THE UNDERSIGNED, agree that I choose to participate voluntarily in the competition with my horse, as a rider, driver, handler, lessee, owner, agent, coach, trainer, or as parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor, and am fully aware and acknowledge that horse sports and the competition involve inherent dangerous risks of accident, loss and serious bodily injury including broken bones, head injuries, trauma, pain suffering or death. I agree to indemnify (that is, to pay any losses, damages or costs incurred by) the competition, the show management, St. Peter's Church, NEHC, and the Town of Bethany, and to hold them harmless with respect to claims for harm to me or my horse and from any harm caused by me or my horse to others, at the competition.
